Course for Recorder with Lucia Mense (www.luciamense.de)

Soloist, Chamber musician and Pedagogue, Cologne

Interpretation of baroque music according to the historical performance practise; sound shaping and articulation; musical rhetoric, effects and their performance; ornamentation.

Course for Flute with Natalia Gerakis (www.nataliagerakis.com)

Soloist, Orchestra and Chamber Musician, Pedagogue, Stuttgart/Athens

The course adresses young professionals, music students, music teachers, scholars, as well as advanced amateurs, who will have the opportunity to meet and work in a relaxed and pleasant environment. Solo and chamber music repertoire for flute and piano, as well as basic technical issues, are the main focus of this course. The participants will intensively work individually and in the group on the realization of one's own targets, the preparation of concerts, competitions and auditions. Each participant should prepare 2-3 pieces of his choice.

In addition to the individual lessons there will be the possibility to play **chamber music** with participants of the parallel courses for **Recorder**, **Guitar** and **Harpsichord/Pianoforte**.
